Class Size: -Average number of students assigned to a homeroom, compared with the average for districts of similar type (elementary/middle or high school).

Mobility Rate: -This is the percentage of students who entered and left during the school year. The calculation is derived by the sum of students entering and leaving after the October enrollment count divided by the total enrollment.

Student/Faculty Ratio: -This is the number of students per faculty member. It is calculated by dividing the reported October school enrollment by the combined full-time equivalents (FTEs) of classroom teachers and educational support services personnel assigned to the school in October of the school year.

NJASK4: -New Jersey Assessment of Skills and Knowledge 4 (NJASK4) was administered to fourth-graders for the first time in the spring of 2003. It replaces the School Proficiency Assessment (ESPA) that was last administered in the spring of 2002. Based on their score in each section, students are identified as Partially Proficient, Proficient, and Advanced Proficient. The figures represent the percentage of students who achieved Proficient or Advanced Proficient. A Science section was added in the 2004-2005 school year.

GEPA: -New Jersey Assessment of Skills and Knowledge 8 (NJASK8) is used to identify students who need help in reading, writing or mathematics if they are to pass the State's High School Proficiency Assessment a few years later. Based on their score in each section, students are identified as Partially Proficient, Proficient, and Advanced Proficient. The figures represent the percentage of students who achieved Proficient or Advanced Proficient.

HSPA: -High School Proficiency Assessment (HSPA) -Percentage of students who passed all three sections (reading, writing and mathematics) on their first try, in the fall of their junior year. Students are required to pass the test to obtain a diploma, though students who fail one or all the parts can be judged to graduate based on other

SAT: -Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) The average score on the Math and Verbal portions of the SAT (in addition to the essay portion-not shown here), which is taken voluntarily by most students who intend to attend college. Each portion is graded on a scale of 200 to 800 points. The average score for each school is greatly affected by the percentage of students taking the test. In general, the higher the participation, the lower the average score.

Notes: *In the 2006-2007 school year, 2 new schools have been added.
